HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2017-2018

THE SCHOOL

St. Edward is private four-year college preparatory high school enrolling 382 students in grades 9–12. The school opened in the fall of 1941 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 1944. St Edward is accredited by **Advance ED** and the **Illinois State Board of Education**.

THE STUDENTS

The student body is culturally diverse with a population that is 20% Hispanic, 1% African American, 44% white and 9% Asian, multiracial 3%.

CURRICULUM

The academic program consists of 7 class periods in which there is 45 minutes of instruction. Seven credits per semester is the maximum course load.

The school offers 24 different honors classes. Student placement in honors courses is dependent upon teacher recommendations. There are 8 AP classes currently offered: Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Computer Science, Language Composition, Literature, Psychology. AP is an open enrollment program.

Grade Point Average (GPA) Calculation

GPA is computed using the above quality points. Beginning with grade nine, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation. A minimum of 25 credits are **required for graduation**. In addition, each student must complete **40-hours of community service and participate in a three-day spiritual retreat**.
