The driving skills they first learn set the foundation for becoming safe and accident-free drivers throughout their adult lives. Our driving program is designed to give students the good start they need.

## Getting started in Driver's Education:

In Illinois, most young people learn to drive in high school or at a commercial driver training school licensed by the Illinois Secretary of State. Drive Now Driving School is a State certified facility that offers driver education to high school students as well as adults. Each driving instructor has been tested and licensed by the state of Illinois. Our approved driver education classes include 30 hours of classroom study and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel training. Enrollment in a Driver's Education course is required for teens 15-17 prior to obtaining their learner's permit, and receiving their Driver's License. The full course takes a minimum of 4 weeks to complete and classes are offered after school, evenings, and weekends. If you're ready to learn how to drive, follow the next 4 steps and you'll be on your way to earning your driver's license.

## STEP 1 - Student Eligibility:

This section outlines the age and legal requirements you must meet in order to be eligible for our Driver Education and Driver Training classes at <u>ST. EDWARDS HIGH SCHOOL.</u>

## Course qualifications and requirements:

· You must turn 15 before the end of the course you're enrolled in

· All students under the age of 17 and 9 months are required to take driver education to receive a license

• Each student must receive a passing grade in at least 8 courses during the previous 2 semesters, prior to enrolling, to be eligible to take driver's education

Each student is required to complete and pass 30 hours of classroom study and 6 hours of Behind-the-Wheel training
The following forms must be filled out and turned in to Drive Now: <u>Driver\_Education\_Approval\_Form, S.O.S Approval</u>
Form and Teen Policy/Participation Agreement.

## STEP 2 - Course Details:

Our course includes an emphasis on the development of knowledge, attitudes, habits, and skills necessary for the safe operation of motor vehicles. With all of our driver's education materials, teens will learn all about the basics of driving which includes: the rules of the road, how to deal with different driving conditions, how to react in emergencies, and everything they need to know to become safe and responsible drivers.

#### **Classroom Studies:**

Classroom instructions will be given in fifteen, two hour sessions, during a minimum period of 4 weeks, with no more than one session a day. Any classroom sessions missed must be made up to successfully pass this course. Both the midterm and final exam tests require a 75% or higher to pass.

## Behind-the-Wheel:

A student may schedule Behind-the-Wheel lessons only when they have received their Learner's Permit. To obtain a Learner's Permit you must be enrolled in a Driver's Education Program. After the third class, students are given a practice Permit test. If they pass, Drive Now will issue an Illinois Secretary of State (S.O.S.) form allowing them to take the Permit test at an S.O.S. office. Generally, two students are grouped together for 90 minutes of driving session. The Drive Now school policy is on the web site.
